The framework

The Alpine Region faces common challenges to be tackled. Specifically there is a need to:

- Reduce the gap between urbanized and rural/mountain areas;
- Reduce the aging process in alpine mountains;
- Promote new sustainable development models (in line with the EU Green Deal)

There is a lack of courses targeted specifically at the Alpine Region and young individuals **living in and working for the development of mountain areas able to tackle these issues.**

In this framework Universities can play an essential role in promoting the acquisition of essential skills for young individuals as well as the upskilling of current workers promoting the sustainable development of mountain areas.

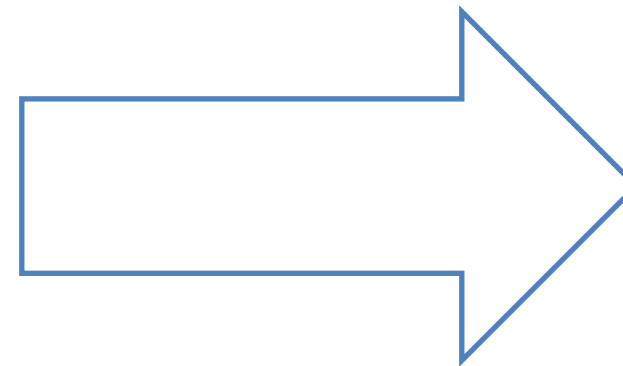


The framework
