



HOW TO GET TO PALAZZO LOMBARDIA, MILAN

Address: Piazza Città di Lombardia, 1, 20124 Milano

By car

Parking near Palazzo Lombardia:

For parking your car or motorcycle, there are some parking lots along the adjacent streets of the Palace.

Here is the list of covered and paid parking lots located near the headquarters of the Region.

Restelli New Park: via Francesco Restelli 3/3 in front of Palazzo Lombardia, parking is always open 24/7 and 7 days a week.

Autosilo Pola: via Pola 9/11 the car park is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year

Parking Park Einaudi: Piazza Einaudi 1

Parking is open:

- from Monday to Friday from 7.00 to 21.30
- Saturday from 7.30 am to 2.00 pm
- Sunday and holidays closed.

Availability of parking spaces: 464 + 18 for the disabled

Price list - hourly rate:

1 hour € 1.50

2 hours € 2.50

3 hours € 3.10

4 hours € 3.60

integration fees over 4 hours € 0.50

Parking International: Via Galvani 12.

Parking is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. It has 300 parking spaces and 50 bike spaces

Price list- hourly rate:

1 hour € 3.00

every hour after the first € 2.00 (for a total of € 15.00 for 24 hours)

Garage Parking 2000: Via Achille Zanon 2 (near Central Station)

Parking is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
