EUSALP is the fourth macro-regional strategy of the European Union and includes 48 regions from France, Germany, Switzerland, Liechtenstein, Austria, Italy and Slovenia. Enhanced cooperation, economic, social and territorial cohesion are some of its many objectives. Its internal architecture includes a General Assembly (GA), an Executive Board (EB) and 9 Action Groups (AG) dealing with specific topics. The Autonomous Province of Trento leads Action Group 3, which deals with training, education and labour market: its mission is to "Improve the adequacy of labour market, education and training in strategic sectors".

Currently, all 9 AGs are engaged in the implementation of the AlpGov 2 Interreg Project that aims to strengthen the Strategy's multilevel governance structures and mechanisms while proposing strategic initiatives. It will run from January 2020 to June 2022. AlpGov 2 is funded under the Interreg Alpine Space programme, has a budget of € 3,003,076.80 and is financed with ERDF and national funds.

Important topics for our AG are: collaborative digital environment, strengthening education, training and skills of workers in EUSALP countries, digital jobs, green jobs and skills of the future, lifelong learning.
