The territory of the Mediterranean Alps, straddling department of Alpes-Maritimes, Piemonte and Liguria is, like the rest of the Alps, subject to a rapid climate change. In a territory severely affected by the storm « Alex » on 2th and 3th October, 2020, adaptation to climate change is of particular importance. It's in this context that the Interreg ALCOTRA ALPIMED CLIMA project is developing a cross-border climate charter.

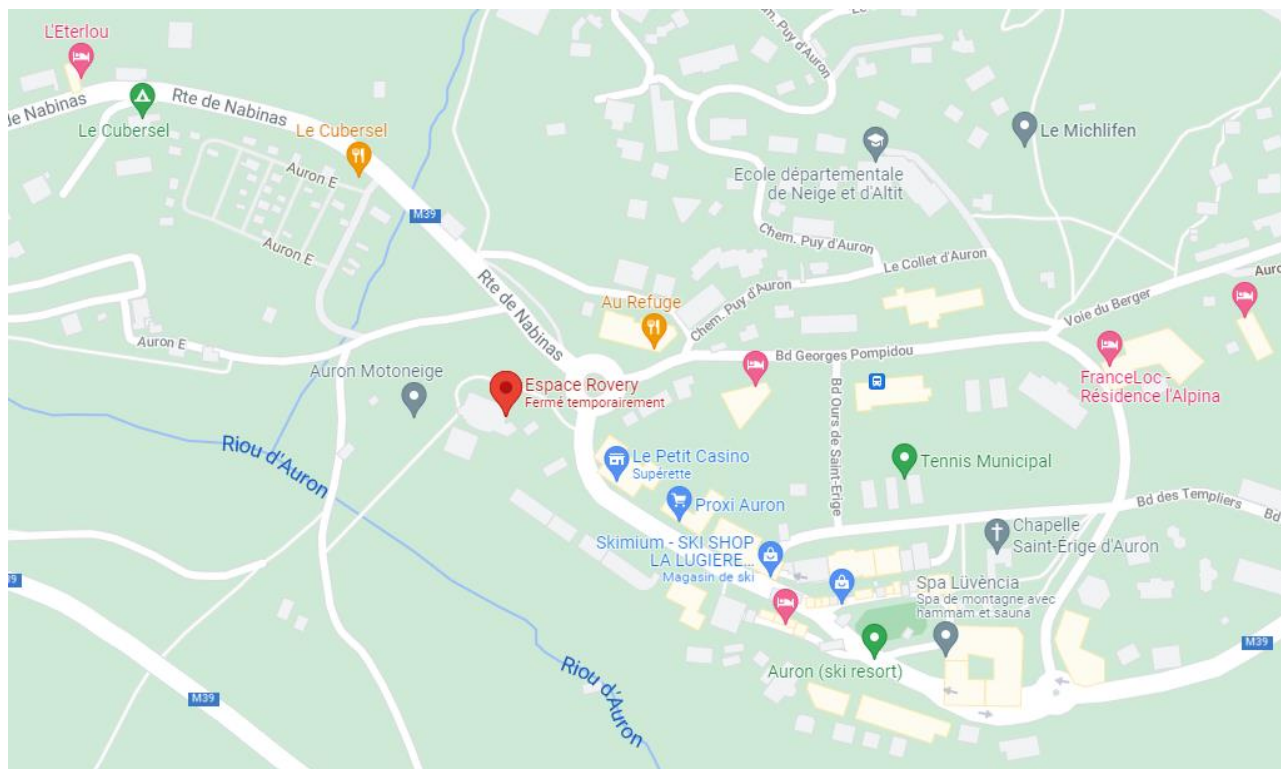
