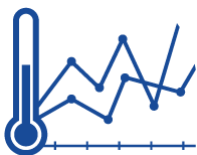

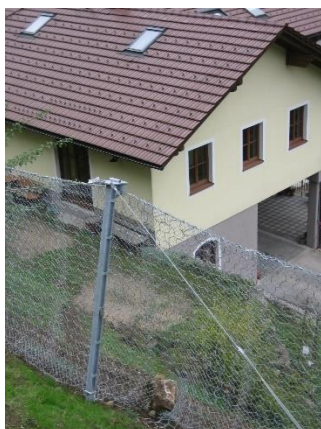

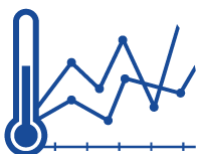

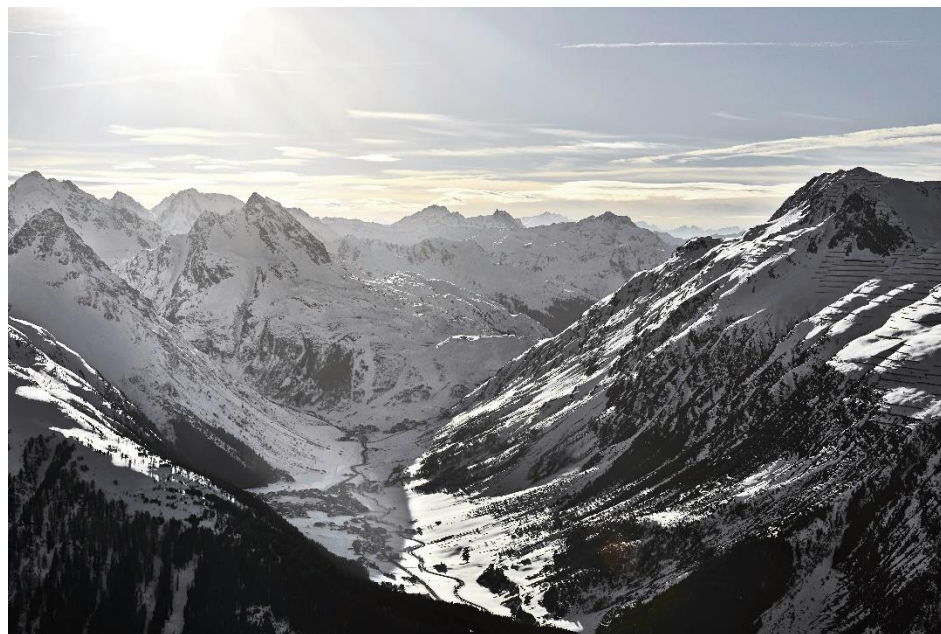

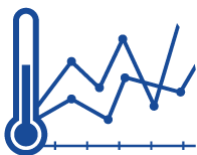

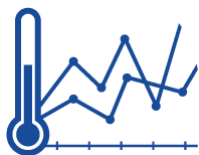

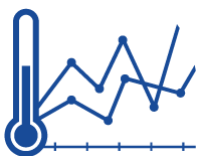




Even **natural hazard experts** were amazed by the high quality and creativity of the younger generation to meet the future challenges of natural hazards in a changing climate.
